III. Review and Approval of Meeting Notes for August 11, 2015 meeting

Mr. Barnett made a motion to accept the meeting notes from the August 11th meeting. Mr. Benton seconded the motion. Motion passed.

IV. Review and discussion and Recommendation Regarding List of Projects for inclusion into the 2040 MTP and the 2015-2018 TIP

 Mr. Welzenbach referred to the two spreadsheets he had sent out to the TAC members earlier in the week. He noted that both spreadsheets were an attempt to break the list of projects out into five year increments within the 25 year span of the 2040 MTP. One sheet (Option A)was his attempt to be as fair as possible and the other (Option B) was an attempt to accommodate the priorities as submitted by the respective cities.

Based on the two spreadsheets, Mr. Welzenbach stated that it was his hope that one of the lists (or amended/edited lists) would be recommended to the MPO Policy Board.

There then ensued an extensive discussion as to which of the two lists should be the starting point for the TAC and whether or not the priorities of the respective cities were, in fact, accommodated.

Mr. Farley from the City of Pottsboro noted that the median configuration at FM 120 and SH 289 was going to be accommodated without the use of Prop 1 funds and could therefore come off the list.

Mr. McManus stated that he didn't think the list accurately reflected the priorities of Van Alstyne. He noted that in the list that had been sent to the MPO SH 5 and not FM 121 was the top priority for Van Alstyne. Mr. Welzenbach apologized for his misunderstanding and the TAC then proceeded to edit the project list with that difference in mind. On the master list of projects (the list not broken out into five year increments) the project listings for the Van Alstyne priorities were project numbers 24, 43, and 83-85 and 91. Mr. McManus stated that project #83 on the master list was Van Alstyne's top priority. More discussion ensued but eventually a modified list of projects was agreed upon by the TAC members.

A motion was made by Mr. Hockersmith to recommend Option B with the modifications agreed to. The motion was seconded by Mr. Barnett and passed unanimously.
